

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The education is part of the field of Ministry of Education and Culture and the Finnish National Board of Education and it is regulated by the Vocational Education and Training Act (531/2017) and Decree (673/2017).

The education follows the guidelines of qualification requirements for Vocational Education in Business (21.12.2017, OPH-2697-2017) by the Finnish National Board of Education.

Vocational qualification is an upper secondary vocational qualification preceded by comprehensive school and consistent with the decree (2.10.2017, A 680/2017) given by the Ministry of Education and Culture.

Vocational Qualification is on level 4 according to the Finnish National Qualifications Framework and European Qualifications Framework.

Vocational Qualification provides eligibility to higher education at polytechnics and universities.

Vocational qualification consists of 180 competence points (cp) corresponding to 3 years of studies. One year of studies corresponds to approximately 60 competence points.
